Official Languages

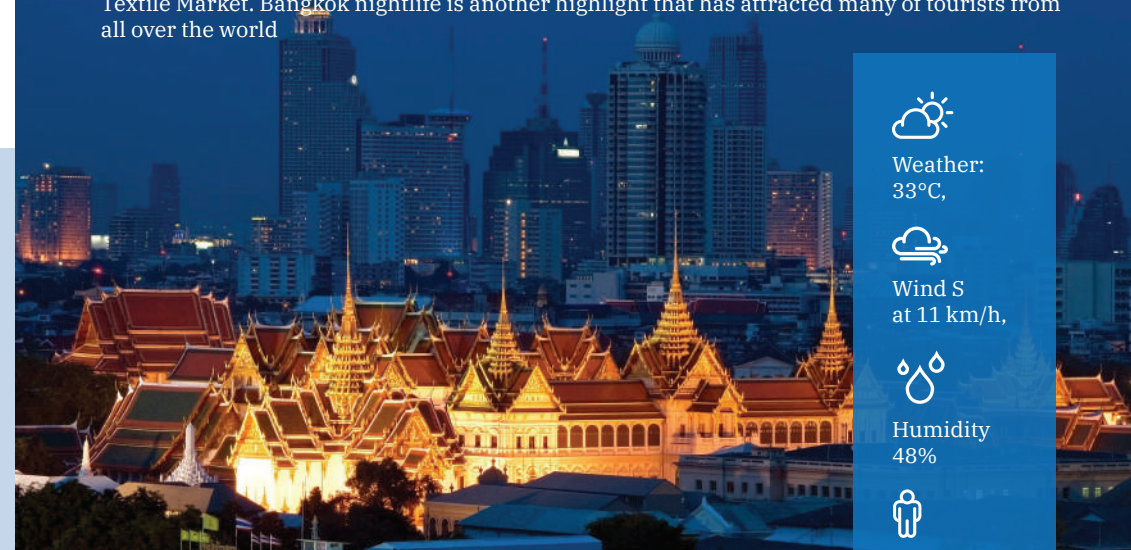
The official language of The 8th Asia Pacific IIW International Congress is English. The paper must be prepared in accordance with IIW document.
